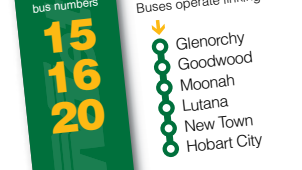

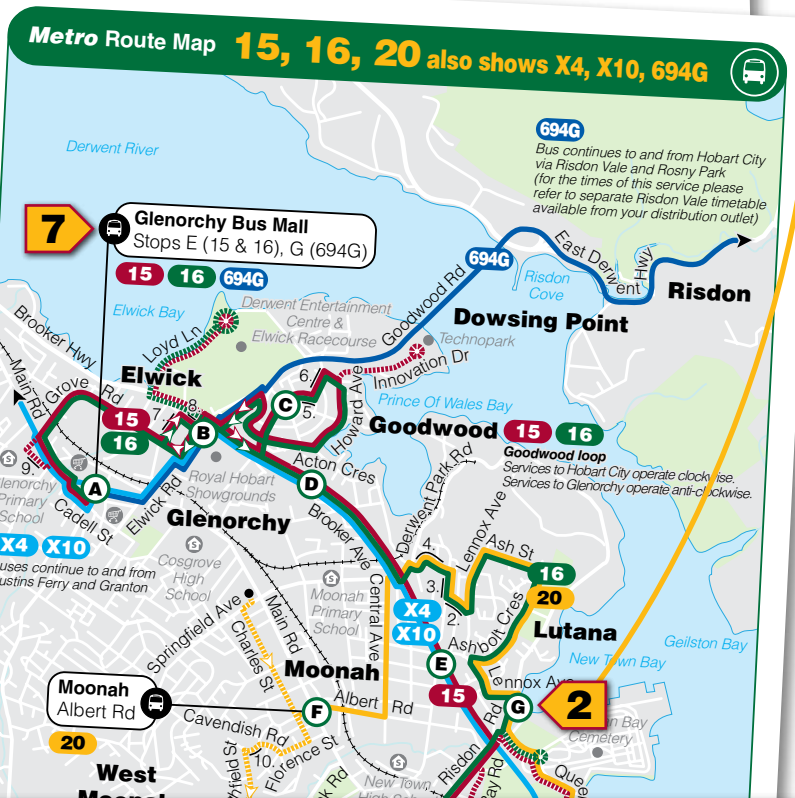

- 1** The header shows the travel direction of the timetable below.
- 2** Large letters in circles are timing points along bus routes. These correspond to the same letters in circles shown on the route map. This allows you to know which bus stops times are shown for.
- 3** Approximate arrival times of buses are listed below each timing point. PM (afternoon/evening) times are shown in cream shading.
- 4** Bus route numbers are shown in the left column of the timetable.
- 5** Bold letters next to a time or route number indicate a specific journey note which can be found under the *Explanations* heading.
- 6** Supplementary notes are shown to the side of or below the tables.
- 7** Terminus points of each bus route (where journeys start and end) are shown in white bubbles on the map.
- 8** The front cover gives a general overview of routes and areas covered by the timetable.
